Discussion Questions

Date: April 21, 2019 | Scripture: John 20:1-10, 19-20

- 1. Jesus still bears scars as a "uniform of grace." What are a few reasons why this is important?
- 2. Because Jesus died and rose, our goodness is irrelevant because no one could ever be good enough to be made right with God. What difference does this make in how you relate to him?
- 3. Because Jesus died and rose, our badness is irrelevant. We can never "out-sin" the grace of God. What difference does this make in how you relate to him?
- 4. Jesus says "take the focus off yourself, and put your focus on me." What makes this difficult to do sometimes? How has the Easter season refocused your heart and mind toward God?
- 5. How was the experience of inviting someone to church this Easter? What was challenging about it? What was encouraging about it?
- 6. How can we continue to be outward facing as a church, post Easter?

This is the good news of Easter: that Jesus really did die, and in so doing he paid for our sins, but he really did rise - rise so that we may have freedom and life.
